Along with every other parish in the United States we welcome our Holy Father Pope Francis to this great land. As I write this article in advance of this weekend, I wonder what messages the Holy Father will impart to Catholic families, to world leaders and to our President and Congress. How blessed we are by the visit of Pope

Francis and yet we too must be challenged to listen to his messages and begin to put them into force. We know that as a country we are privileged in that many of us have a strong economic life. The challenge from this of course is to share not from our surplus but to share with sacrifice and do without so that others who have less may benefit.

The family unit needs to be strong, centered on God, and needs to be led by the strong combination of a husband and wife who teach their children the masculine and feminine qualities necessary to be a whole and functioning human being. Family life in our country however, has been under stress for many years. Divorce, single parenting, parents working long excessive hours outside the home, parents who can't get a job, parents who struggle, parents who are strongly Catholic, parents who are weak in faith all are signs and symbols of the average American family in 2015. Here at St. Rose I applaud all our active families who are centered on Christ. For those of our families who do not attend Mass on a weekly basis, I strongly encourage as much as possible, to have the parent, or preferably the parents, practice their faith, teach their children to pray and establish a habit of daily family prayer with weekly Mass. By a stronger practice of their faith, their children receive the strength and courage that only the Holy Eucharist, through the scripture, can give.




