*Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time July 24, 2016*



**I have been blessed by a wonderful caring family; my parents came from large loving families who taught us to be strong and loving in our faith. My mother was one of 10 children, one of her sisters Ellen moved to Philadelphia in 1972. Ellen was a maternity nurse and loved to travel and see different places. She worked as a maternity nurse in Libya in the 1960's and there met Mounir Louka, who she would later marry. Mounir Louka was an OBGYN who set up practice at Jefferson Hospital in Philadelphia and my aunt helped run the practice. They had 4 wonderful children each of whom I had the pleasure to celebrate their weddings. My Aunt Ellen has 7 grandchildren, I baptized 5 and 2 baptism are still pending.**

**I started to visit the United States as a seminarian in 1986 and Philadelphia became my American base. My aunt and uncle welcomed me and any of my friends with open arms, a little drink, and plenty of food! My uncle sadly had a severe stroke about 30 years ago. My Aunt Ellen became his primary caretaker and lovingly cared for him until he died about 14 years ago. Last Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup>, my aunt passed into eternal life, having battled emphysema, heart failure and cancer for some time. She was a strong Catholic woman and gave her children the foundation of their strong faith, the faith which they are now handing down to their children. I know that the Lord has embraced my loving aunt and given her the glory of heaven. We, her family, continue to live our Catholic faith and appreciate the foundation built for us by those of our family who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.**

**As you are aware this Sunday, the 24th of July we leave for our pilgrimage to Poland. Because of fear of terrorism, Bishop Serratelli after prayerful consideration, decided not to lead this pilgrimage. Stephanie and I held a meeting about 1 month ago, so our group could discuss the situation. We were mainly concerned that we had some minors who were traveling without a parent. Two of our parents naturally felt concerned at being so far away from their children should anything happen. These two teenagers, upon the advice of their parents, and with our complete approval, decided not to travel. One of our minors invited her dad to join us. I'm happy to tell you that despite the fear of terrorism, etc., two minors, accompanied by a parent are joining us, two young adults and thirteen adults. The total number representing St. Rose will be seventeen. Included in this number are Alex and Deacon Michael who will be in Krakow Monday when we arrive. There will be twelve residents of our diocese who will travel with us, one of which is a priest, Fr. Matt Twiggs, pastor of St. Thomas Church in Oakridge, NJ.**

**The prayer intentions which you gave us are now in a beautiful booklet which we will bring to every Daily Mass I will celebrate. Though our numbers are smaller than anticipated, we set out with great courage and joy to bring our parish to Krakow and to open our hearts to the prompting of the Holy Spirit.**

**Be aware of our prayers during this special time of pilgrimage; please keep us in your prayers.**



## News from Rome

Today, July 20th, is my last day on the island of Lesbos. I will be taking an 8pm ferry to go back to Athens, where I will continue working at the Jesuit Shelter for Vulnerable Refugees until Saturday. I then will head up to Poland to get ready to meet the pilgrims from our parish going to World Youth Day. Today is also a very special day for my family. I want to first take the time to congratulate my parents, Bill & Florence on their 25th Anniversary of Marriage. I also want to wish my father a Happy 65th Birthday, he was smart, he got married on his birthday so he would never forget the anniversary!

As I prepare to leave Lesbos, I wanted to reflect about the amazing opportunity this has been to work with refugees. I was able to share my talents, but more importantly, I was able to have my heart changed by theirs. When we open our heart to the other person and share in a mutual self-giving, we are bound to share in the other. This means taking on their suffering into our own heart, but also their joy and hope for a better future. A hope that one day, their country will no longer be fighting and they can return back safely.

Further, it is not just the hope of the refugees that has affected me, but the desire to serve there I have seen in so many of the volunteers. I think to a group of four Portuguese Catholics I met, who you could see, when they would pick up a child or speak with adults, they did it with such love burning in their hearts. They saw Christ in the little ones. I pray that I will always continue to imitate this in my actions. Allowing the love of Christ to help me serve those who need it most, the little ones. To make me recognize every person as a creation of God and thus allowing all of the flaws, brokenness, and sins to melt away, to see them as another Christ.

I will especially have a part of my heart saved for the children of the Caritas hotel. To see their ability to forget the evil they saw, and rather look out to the good they know God will provide. A good that is sometimes worked through us in our actions, or even in our prayers. I encourage you to pray for them, and if you like, you can send them short letters and assurances of your prayers, I have made sure to include the address. (Don't worry about the language barrier, they have translators there who will help.) I also ask you to pray for all the pilgrims who are leaving Poland for this week of prayer with our Holy Father and an encounter with Christ.
