Each year we hold our Antioch Retreat mid-January. In the last several years Stephanie has developed an amazing young group of people called the Antioch Team. These are young people in the 11th and 12th grades who are gifted, caring and with a great sense of faith give time to their younger peers in the 10th grade and witness for them what it means to be Catholic. This past weekend our 10th graders attended their Antioch Retreat in preparation for their Confirmation. This year we have our biggest Antioch Team ever – twenty-one loyal and true members! Our team leaders are Eric Magnifico and Lindsey Schiffner. Our adult leaders Stephanie Politi, Lisa Paradiso and Alex Keenan oversaw the preparation for the retreat and the retreat itself. A big thank you as always to Mike and Robin Giamarino who provided, prepared and helped serve the food over the weekend and to the parents who assisted them with this. A big thank you to you, our parishioners, for your support of youth ministry. Please keep our young people in your prayers over the next few months as they continue to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Several years ago we began our Pilgrim Ministry. Many people like to vacation in the islands or take cruises but a pilgrimage is something different. A pilgrimage is a time to have fun, pray, make new friends, celebrate Mass in an ancient cathedral, abbey or church and walk in the footsteps of thousands of Catholics from the 12th century who, like us, have proclaimed Jesus as their risen Lord and Savior. I'm thrilled to announce that we have decided to make Portugal and Northern Spain our next pilgrimage destination. This year we celebrate the 100th Anniversary of the appearance of our Blessed Mother to three shepherd children. Our Blessed Mother appeared six times to the children inviting them to tell the world that if her requests were listened to the world would live in peace and many souls would go to Heaven. Each time we pray the Rosary we conclude each decade with the Fatima prayer. Portugal is an amazing country with a rich and ancient culture. They have an amazing variety of food, delicious wines and of course are famous for their port. We will have a presentation on this Tuesday, January 24th at 7:00pm with information regarding our visit to the beautiful Shrine of Fatima and the amazing holy cathedrals we will visit both in Portugal and at the Shrine of Santiago (the basilica built to honor the Apostle James who brought the faith to that area) in Northern Spain.

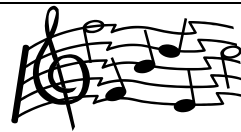

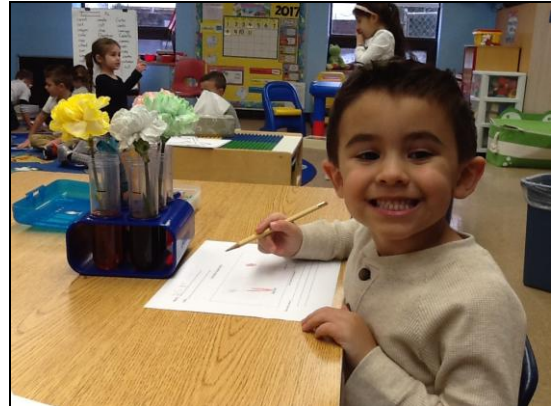
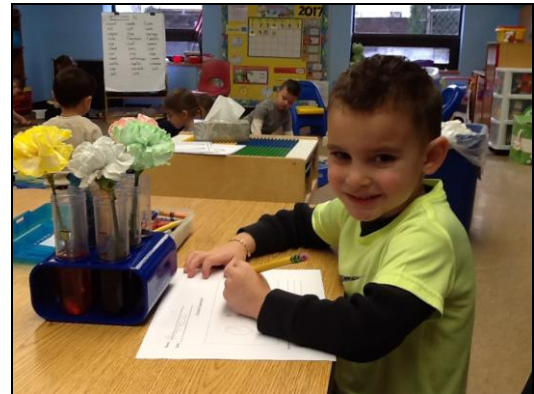
EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER

This week in the Pre-Kindergarten classes we worked on the letter "C". The children were encouraged to write the letter C, paint the letter C, and we had a show and tell session using an item from home that began with the letter C. Our science experiment this week focused on "Coloring a Carnation." Several carnations were put into a solution of food coloring and water and the children observed what happened. The children noticed the color of the carnation was changing and they recorded their results into our STEM Journals. It was so exciting to come into school the next day to find out what happened to our carnations! They look beautiful! We also discussed the process that occurs when a flower "drinks" water through their roots.

In our preschool classes, the children took turns using the various centers within the classroom. The children are also practicing how to spell their name using fun snowman pieces. They are also enjoying their time on the SMART board, playing educational games and learning through technology in a fun and exciting way!

This past week we kicked off our first Simply Science class with Mr. Mike with a cool and colorful experiment! We first made predictions on what we thought would happen if we poured cold or warm water on a plate outlined with skittles. The result was an amazing colorful surprise! We had a blast watching the colors run from the skittles into a swirly shape and thought it was amazing that the S came off and floated on top of the water!
