Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time February 5, 2017



The Lord has blessed us in so many ways here at St. Rose. Our 2nd graders are busy preparing for their First Reconciliation February 10th, 17th, 24th, and March 10th. Let us keep our little ones in prayer during these days when they prepare to meet Jesus Christ in the healing sacrament of forgiveness. I hope and pray this celebration of their First Reconciliation will be an opportunity for them to understand the gift of confession and that from then for the rest of their lives they will come frequently and devoutly to Christ in the sacrament.

After many years of hard work and financial sacrifice the work is almost completed on our Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Paterson. Our cathedral will be rededicated by Bishop Serratelli on the Feast of St. John the Baptist on Saturday, June 24th at 10:00am. This will be a joyful liturgy and how great it will be finally to be able to concelebrate with our Bishop in the cathedral which we all love so much. Our ordinations have been delayed from their usual May date to July 1st so that our Transitional Deacons can be ordained in our newly renovated cathedral.

Deacon Michal and Deacon Andrew have been given formal notice that they are accepted by our bishop to be ordained priests on Saturday, July 1st. This will be a life changing day for both men as they will then promise obedience to our Bishop and his successor and make the promise of celibacy. Through the laying on of hands, our Bishop will ordain them for the holy priesthood. Keep Deacon Michal and Deacon Andrew in prayer during these final months of preparation.

Seminarian Kamil has been given formal notice that he will be ordained a deacon on Saturday, May 13th at St. Peter's Church in Parsippany. Kamil will, as is the custom, be ordained a Transitional Deacon for approximately one year. During the next year he will prepare, through the grace of God, for his ordination to priesthood on Memorial Day weekend 2018. Please keep Kamil in prayer in these final months of preparation.

Our sympathy, love and prayers go out to Larry and Audrey Colasurdo on the death of their beloved son Larry. I con-celebrated Larry's Funeral Mass at his parish of St. Virgil's in Morristown. Our prayers surround his wife Geralyn and his daughters Diana and Jackie. Larry Jr. was a strong Catholic man of faith. We pray for strength and courage for his beloved family as they continue their journey of faith with Christ as their guide.

We extend our prayers also to the Almeida and Neto families on the death of Manny, a wonderful old man who died at the age of 98. I celebrated Manny's Funeral Mass on Saturday. We surround his children Joe, Aida, Joanne, Manny and Maria with our prayers at this time.

Last Monday night Fr. Matthew returned from a visit with his family in Poland. I was thrilled he could spend some time with his parents, brothers, and family. His family fostered his vocation and we're very glad to have Fr. Matthew home with us again.
