In the name of our Bishop and on my behalf I thank you my beloved parishioners for the love and great trust you place in me as your pastor. The gift of priesthood is indeed a blessing and your support of the priesthood and of my role as your pastor gives me the strength and courage to work tirelessly for you and all who need my help in anyway. We're blessed in our diocese to have so many men who are preparing for the priesthood. Your financial, prayerful and practical support to the young men I mentor is an invaluable help to their formation. I love to hear our young men boast to their friends of how wonderful the parish of St.

Rose is and how they have been embraced by their new parish family.

It's hard to believe that Fr. Matthew will celebrate his 2nd Anniversary to the priesthood on May 27th, and Fr. Hubert celebrated his 8th Anniversary on May 23rd. Fr. Matthew is very happy at St. Rose and we're very happy to have him with us. Fr. Hubert has retained a close love for our parish and we certainly love him.

Deacon Andrew flies home on Tuesday, June 20th and will stay with us until his ordination. It's been a pleasure to have him with us the past two summers. I know he has learned a lot pastorally from the time in our parish. After ordination Andrew will return to Rome for a further year of studies in Sacred Scripture.

He will probably be placed in a different parish for a varied experience but of course as this is his parish home, he'll spend time here before and after his assignment. He's excited to come home. It's been a long and difficult two years (Seminary is a little bit like boot camp!). I'm happy to tell you his reports are excellent and he's doing beautifully. However, he's yearning to come home for the summer and for a taste of America, and missing Doritos and taylor ham. What can I say! It will be great to have him home for the summer. He can't wait to share his stories.
