*Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time June 25 2017*



On this Saturday of June 24<sup>th</sup>, the Feast of St. John the Baptist, with great joy we rededicated our Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Paterson City. We the priests, with lay representatives, gathered with Bishop Serratelli in the seat of our diocese to give thanks to God for the great sacrifice given by parishioners throughout the diocese to make this possible. Thanks to everyone at St. Rose who took part in the Partners in Faith Campaign which helped to raise the millions of dollars necessary to reconstruct, repair and beautify our cathedral.

Deacon Michal and Deacon Andrew are counting the days – one week to their Ordination to Priesthood at the cathedral. With great excitement Alex returned to St. Rose last Monday evening. We look forward to having him with us until mid-August. He is a great help in the preparations for the ordinations and for the two first Masses.
