Matthew I welcome Mother Mario Maduka to our parish this weekend. We are delighted to host Mother Mario and certainly look forward to hearing about the wonderful work she and her community are involved in. We will have a second collection this weekend to give practical support to their mission. Please see the letter below from Mother Mario.

Fr. Owen

The Missionary Daughters of the Eternal Father is a congregation known for the work of evangelization. We live a life of perfect charity through caring for the poor, the sick, the aged, the prisoners and evangelizes through the provision of education to the less privileged, the neglected and abused young girls.

We have our headquarters/formation house in the Catholic diocese of Koudogou in Burkina Faso, West Africa with Bishop Joachin Ouadraogo, bishop of Koudogou diocese as our principal bishop/spiritual father.

Our communities in Burkina Faso and other parts of the world reach out to the poor, the sick and the physically challenged by providing them with wheel chairs, crutches, walking sticks, medications, education, housing, food, clothing, diapers, transportations and financial assistance.

We work with minority Christian families in a predominantly Moslem region of Burkina Faso. We do not receive any form of payment or government subsidy for our outreach programs.

We have the zeal to reach a greater population but we are challenged by financial constraints. Since our work is missionary and we depend on the good will and generosity of the people of God, especially in our Catholic faith, this is why we have come to appeal to you the good people of God to assist us. It is only through your generosity that we will be able to provide the needs of those destitute that benefit from our ministry.

We need your help to be able to build a continuing care retirement community that offers a full spectrum of lifestyle options that promote engagement, wellness and vitality, trying to build up a program enabling older adults still living at home to enjoy community and fellowship.

We need your help to provide an opportunity for young women and men with economic need to obtain a Catholic college preparatory education made affordable through an innovative corporate work study program [skills].

We also need your help to build a residential facility for children and adults with severe mental and multiple physical disabilities.

NEWS FROM PORTUGAL

The name of my normal column must change, since I am in Portugal for the next three weeks. However, I want to spend this time to say thank you. This summer has been such a great experience and a time to re-energize. I was especially happy to have been assigned to my home parish of St. Rose. As some of you know, this normally doesn't happen, so I am grateful to the Bishop for making that decision.

It is a strange feeling going back to the seminary, I am both happy and sad. The summer flew by, and it is hard for me to believe that two months have passed since I returned from Rome. I know that I need to go back to seminary and finish my studies, but it is always difficult to leave home and all the people that I love and care about at St. Rose. However, I am also excited to be going back and getting to see all of my friends from seminary, I know that the end is in sight. God-willing, I will be ordained a transitional deacon after this year, the last step before priesthood, but also the point when a man becomes part of the clergy.

I know this might be surprising to some young people, but I do enjoy studying and learning more about the rich theology and history of our Church. Although I must admit, I do not like having to take tests and write papers. Going anywhere is always filled with mixed emotions, sadness for people we leave behind, excitement for the people we will see, and looking forward to going back to see our friends and family back home.

I know this is my 9th time doing this type of trip, having already spent 8 years of my life in university, but I know for many in our parish, this is their first time. I want to let all of those going to college know that you are in my prayers as you enter this new stage of your life. And for those going back, I can tell you that although it gets a little easier after the first time, it never becomes routine. St. Rose is a home to us all, a place where we can feel safe and comfortable. A place where we feel the love of Christ around us, and where we can see Him present in actions. I keep all of you in my prayers and I ask that you do the same for me. I look forward to another year in seminary, and of course remember, all roads lead to Rome. 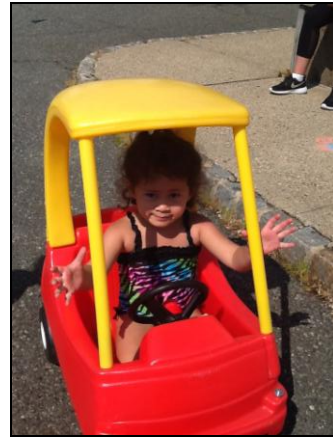
